

## Scitech STEM Club 2018

Scitech is excited to offer the Years 4 to 6 students at Woodlupine Primary School the opportunity to participate in a new Science After School initiative that is designed to engage not only talented science students, but also those that are enthusiastic about science, technology, engineering or mathematics and wish to further their interest outside the classroom over a 6 month intensive STEM Club at Woodlupine Primary School.

The STEM Club will be offered from on Wednesday afternoon's from 3:00 to 4:00 starting on the 21<sup>st</sup> February and ending on the 20<sup>th</sup> June. The cost of the 16 week series is a flat rate of \$160 and it will be the parents/guardians responsibility to ensure the student attends each workshop. There will be an opportunity for 20 students from Years 4 to 6 to attend.

We would like to strongly encourage the parents to participate throughout the program, particularly in the first session, as we will introduce the scope of the program and answer any questions they may have. By encouraging the parents to get involved over the course of the 6 month program we hope to foster science at home and a deeper engagement with their child's learning.

Our highly trained presenters will take duty of care of the students so it will not be a necessity for a teacher to be present at every session.
